ROSTER MUST ACCOMPANY REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

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TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Team rosters may have a maximum of 12 players. Copies of each player's birth certificate should be readily available at the beginning of tournament play.
 2. Players must be in the grade they are playing, unless they move up one grade.
 3. Games consist of (4) 7 minute quarters, running clock. Clock stops **ONLY** on shooting fouls, time-outs, injuries and the last 1 minute of the first half and the last 2 minutes of second half per IHSA rule. A shooting foul occurs when a player gets fouled in the act of shooting. The clock will run during bonus free throws unless it's the last 1 minute of the first half or the last 2 minutes of the second half.
 4. Two timeouts per half, one in overtime. Unused time outs do not carry over.
 5. Half time will be 3 minutes long.
 6. No pressing until the last 1 minute of the first half and the last 2 minutes of the second half. **No pressing if you are winning by 15 points or more.**
 7. Overtime will start with a jump ball after a one-minute intermission and will consist of a two minute long period. The clock will run per IHSA rule. If still tied at the end of that period, the second overtime will start with a jump ball and the first team to score wins. (**NOTE:** This includes one made free throw).
 8. Coaches are responsible for their players and fans. If coaches cannot control their players and fans, that team will be asked to leave the tournament and forfeit the rest of their games.
 9. Any team that is not ready to play five minutes after their scheduled game time will forfeit that game.
 10. When seeding, the winner of the head-to-head game will determine any tiebreaker. If it's a three-way tie, then it will be determined by points against. If still tied, it will be determined by points scored.
 11. All other rules are in accordance with the current IHSA rulebook.
 12. DuPage Youth Travel Basketball (DYTBL) and West Suburban Girls Travel Basketball (WSGB) teams have first priority, then other teams may enter if space is available.
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
