What equipment is needed?

1. Wheaton Park District universal soccer shirt and shin guards are required and must be purchased by participants.
2. Shin guards must be covered by long, FIFA regulation socks.
3. All-purpose athletic soccer shoes with rubber cleats or gym shoes.
4. While not required for your child to participate, it is strongly recommended that each player have their own soccer ball, clearly marked with name, address and phone number. Pee wee and Kindergarten use #3 soccer ball and grades 1st-4th use #4 soccer ball; grades 5th-8th use #5 soccer ball.

Hoodies may be worn under the soccer shirt on cold days.

Jewelry is not permitted unless medically necessary.
